The UPS employee must: • Currently reside in Florida and have resided in Florida for the twelve months immediately preceding the application deadline date. • Have a minimum of one year of employment with the company as of the application deadline date. • Be employed at UPS at the time the awards are announced. *Regular full-time at UPS includes approved leaves of absence with or without compensation for military duty, holding union office, prolonged illness, maternity leave, and personal emergencies. **A permanent part-time employee is someone who works 15 to 25 hours per week, fills a permanent vacancy and has successfully completed their probationary period.
