

THIS PLAN HAS BEEN REVISED. The date for seniors to return books, computers and chargers has been moved to **May 26**th and **May 27**th to provide adequate time for the completion and revision of coursework and the May 20th Mental Health course. **Grades 9-11 on May 28 & 29**.

Gulf High School is pleased to share the plan for students to check out of school this month. Please note the <u>dates</u>, <u>times</u>, and <u>grade levels</u> as indicated. Social distancing required.

If Entering the Building for Locker Clean Out – Face Mask and Book Bag – Social Distance

- When entering the building, students MUST wear a face mask covering the nose and mouth. A bandana or other
 cloth is okay as long as it is tied in place and completely covers the nose and mouth. (You may NOT simply try to pull
 a shirt up over your face.)
- Students should bring a clean bag study enough to hold their belongings that may be emptied out of lockers.
- No one should come to school if experiencing fever, aches, cough, shortness of breath, or any COVID-19 symptoms.
- This is a time to get things done quickly. No socializing please. Maintain 6-foot social distancing at all times.
- Only the GHS student with locker may come in for locker clean out No guests or parents may come inside.
