Summer Suggestions for Your Teens

Looking for activities that your teen can do this summer? Here are a few ideas from the newsletter *Parents Still Make a Difference*:

Starting a business builds skills, teaches responsibility...

Does your teen want to earn some extra money? Have him start his own business. Here are some ideas:

- Pet care. Besides pet sitting, he could offer to walk or bathe pets for a fee.
- Tutoring. If he's a whiz in math or computers, he might earn money tutoring younger students who are struggling.
- Catering. If he enjoys working with food, he might bake and sell homemade treats. Or he could work for people who are having parties at home and need help serving and cleaning up.
- Errands. Who has time to run errands today? Your teen can fill the gap.



Starting a business can do more than help your teen earn money, it can give him a chance to use math and other skills as he develops responsibility.

Promote Reading Daily ...



If your teen never reads for pleasure, resolve to make this the summer he starts. Here are some ideas:

- Set a daily family reading time. Tell your family that 15 minutes after dinner is all you ask. Any kind of reading is allowed.
- Take your teen to the library. If he groans, tell him all he has to do is come in with you.

Chances are, he won't just stand there. Just being in the library makes people start browsing.

- Make a reading chart. No, he's not too old. That concert he wants to attend in July? Tell him he has a better chance of going if he reads three books.

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Explore career options through volunteer service...

Helping a child who is ill can foster a sense of compassion in your teen. It's also a great way to explore career options. If your teen has an interest in working in a medical field, helping a child who is ill can help him decide if he wants to pursue that interest. Here are some ways your teen can help:



- Volunteer at a children's hospital or in the children's ward of your local hospital. Your teen can play board games with the children. He can read to them. He can do puzzles with them. He can share a skill he has, such as playing the guitar. He can do a craft, such as decorating paper bag puppets.
- Make a tape or a video—or burn a CD. A child who is ill may enjoy watching or listening to your teen's creation.

Work with siblings. When a child is ill, a well brother or sister may not receive much attention. A child sitting in the waiting room of a hospital would probably love to play a game with your teen or hear a story.
