About Your PSAT/NMSOT[®] Scores

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) Score Report Plus is intended to help you improve your skills and prepare for college. Don't focus only on your scores. You can learn from your mistakes and focus on strengthening your skills for the future.

Your scores are reported to your school and possibly your district or state education department. As cosponsors of the test, the College Board and National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) also receive scores. The PSAT/NMSQT office does not report scores to colleges, and they should not be included on your transcript.

National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) conducts academic competitions for recognition and college scholarships. To designate students who gualify for recognition in its 2014 competitions, NMSC will consider the 2012 PSAT/NMSQT Selection Index scores of some 1.5 million test-takers (usually high school juniors) who meet program entry requirements. About 55,000 students whose scores gualify them for recognition will be notified by NMSC through their high schools in September 2013. For more information, please visit www.nationalmerit.org.

An asterisk (*) next to your Selection Index score means you do not meet requirements to enter NMSC competitions for awards to be offered in 2014. To find out why, compare your responses to the program entry items listed in the NMSC section on the inside of this report with entry requirements given in the PSAT/NMSQT Official Student Guide and on NMSC's website. If any of your responses to NMSC's eligibility questions are inaccurate or there has been a change in plans that may affect program entry, write immediately to:




