To be eligible, students should be on track to have earned the following credits by the end of their sophomore year:

2 credits in English
1 credit in Algebra 1
1 credit in Geometry
1 credit in Biology 1
1 credit of an equally rigorous Science
1 credit in World History
1 credit in PE
1 credit in Fine Arts
2 credits in Foreign Language (desired)
1 credits in a subject area or electives (3 credits total if there is no Foreign Language)
