FAQ'S

1. *What is the Prom date?*

Friday, April 24, 2020

2. *What is the Prom Location?*

Ruth Eckerd Hall

3. *What time is Prom?*

7:30 p.m.-11:30 p.m.

*All students must be picked up promptly by 11:30 p.m.

4. *Will prom tickets be sold at the door?*

No, prom tickets will not be sold at the door under any circumstances.

5. *When will prom tickets be sold?*

Prom tickets will be sold during both lunches in the cafeteria from 3/30-4/17.

6. *How much do prom tickets cost?*

Prom tickets will cost \$85 per person.

7. *What do I need in order to purchase a prom ticket?*

Any GHS student purchasing a prom ticket must have a completed permission slip along with \$85 at time of purchase. The student cannot be on the no-go list for attendance, discipline, or money owed (textbooks, uniforms, equipment, etc.). The student must also be a junior or senior, unless attending as a guest to a junior or senior student.

8. *What if I want to bring a guest to prom?*

A student requesting to bring a guest, who is not a Gulf High School student, must have a guest form completed with the **principal's approval before** you purchase your tickets. **The deadline for submitting a guest request form to the front office is Wednesday, April 8* no later than 2PM!** The dance policy allows a Gulf High School student to bring one guest, who must be a **high school student** (under the age of 21) within Pasco County School District. The guest must bring a current school ID or photo ID to the social event.

When your guest has been approved, your permission slip will be returned to you and at that time, you can bring the completed permission slip along with \$85 to cafeteria table to purchase their ticket. ***Please note: A guest ticket CANNOT be purchased until the GHS student bringing that guest has purchased their own ticket!

9. *If I need to get ahold of my child at Prom?*

10. *What support staff will be at Prom?*

11. *What does my child need to bring to enter the prom?*

Student must bring Prom ticket and form of ID.

Reminders:

- The Pasco County's Student Code of Conduct will be in effect during Prom (Student code of conduct, page 37).
- There are no school sponsored after Prom activities.
- Party busses will NOT be allowed at prom.
- Students are prohibited from possessing alcohol, hemp, marijuana, THC, and any illegal drug(s), narcotic(s), controlled substance(s), as well as any substance that is represented to contain, mimics, or that looks like the aforementioned items while on a school campus, school bus, at a school sponsored function, or any District School Board of Pasco County property or facility.
