What is the U.S. Armed Forces? In simple terms, the U.S. Armed Forces are made up of the five armed services branches:

- Air Force
- Army
- Coast Guard
- Marine Corps and
- Navy.

The Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) is a college program offered at more than 1,700 college and universities across the United States that prepares young adults to become officers in the U.S. Military. In exchange for a paid college education and a guaranteed post-college career, participants, or cadets, commit to serve in the Military after graduation. Each service branch has its own unique ROTC program.
