<u>Suggested Classroom bell ringer/icebreaker activity:</u> <i>Circle Greeting</i> Create an “inner” circle and an “outer” circle with students facing each other. Students will give a fist or elbow bump and a “good morning!”. Then, ask either the inner or outer circle to rotate to the right and repeat.	<u>Suggested Classroom bell ringer/icebreaker activity:</u> <i>Action Alliteration</i> Give students time to think of an action word that begins with the same letter as their first name. For example student will say “I’m awesome Ann”. The class will respond hey “Awesome Ann”. Repeat for all students.	<u>Suggested Classroom bell ringer/icebreaker activity:</u> <i>College Talk</i> Take 5 minutes at the start of class to talk about where you went to college and the process you went through to decide what to do after high school.	<u>Suggested Classroom bell ringer/icebreaker activity:</u> <i>Dice Greeting</i> All students stand. One student rolls a die and counts that number of students and greets that person. The “roller sits down and the greeted students rolls die next and repeat process.	<u>Suggested Classroom bell ringer/icebreaker activity:</u> <i>Snowball Fight</i> Ask students to write their name on a scrap piece of paper, then ball it up tight. When you say GO, students may throw their “snowball”. They will then pick up a snowball closest to them, open it up, and find the person and greet them.
